### 1- Name of the CSIV

Ambassador Tour by AJA

CSIV- A

### 2- Applicable FEI regulations

The Serie "Ambassador Tour" approved by FEI (see Appendix)

### 3- Schedule and AJA events (*Regulatory complements*)

**Tuesday and Wednesday or Wednesday and Thursday:** arrival of the participants, allocation of the stables, veterinary control of the temperatures

**On the 1st day, it is allowed to start in two classes with the same horse. The other days, one class per horse. Each horse can jump 4 class during the competition.**

**Day 0 :** 3 p.m. entrance vet check  
6.30 p.m. welcome drink

**Day 1 :** **Class 1**, 105 cm in two phases special  
Art. 274.2.5

**Class 2**, 110 cm in two phases special  
Art. 274.2.5

**Class 3**, 120 cm in two phases special  
Art. 274.2.5

Combinations that participate in n°3 are not allowed to participate in competition n°6 (Small Tour Challenge Cup) or n°10 (Small Tour Team competition Friendship Cup) or n°4 or n°8

*From 7.30 p.m. AJA evening*

**Day 2 :**            **Class 4**, 105 cm table A against the clock **with jump-off**  
Art.238.2.2

**Class 5**, 120 cm table A against the clock, **no jump-off**  
Art. 238.2.1

**Class 6**, 110 cm Grand Prix “Challenge Cup”, **in two different rounds**,  
Art. 273.4.3 + Rules AMBASSADOR TOUR Series FEI.  
1<sup>st</sup> round : Table A, against the clock, no water jump,  
There will be a short break between the 2 rounds (max 30 mn), but with  
new course inspection.  
2nd round shortened max. 10 obstacles with a double,  
Only the best 12 riders after the first round, based on their penalties and  
time in the first round, or all the clear rounds, are qualified for the second  
round.

**Combinations that participate in this competition may not have  
participated in competition n°3 (Large Tour).**

**Class 7**, 120 cm, “Ambassador Cup” team competition, **in two identical  
rounds-**  
Art. 273.4.1 + Rules AMBASSADOR TOUR Series FEI.

#### Obstacles and courses

Height 1.20 m maximum with a spread in proportion not exceeding 1.30 m  
(1.70 m for the triple bar). At least two vertical obstacles, which must be 1.25  
m in height (sloping walls do not count as compulsory vertical obstacles). No  
water jump.max. 11 obstacles, including a double and a triple.

A short break between the two rounds (max 30 mn),  
6 teams in the second round.

**Combinations that participate in this competition are not allowed to  
participate in competition n°8 or n°10 (Small Tour Team competition  
Friendship Cup).**

**Day 3:**            **Class 8**, 105 cm Table A against the clock  
Art. 238.2.1

**Class 9**, 115 cm table A against the clock **with jump-off**,  
Art. 238.2.2

**Class 10**, 110 cm, "Friendship Cup" team competition, **in two identical rounds**,

Art. 273.4.1 + Rules AMBASSADOR TOUR Series FEI.

max. 10 obstacles, including 2 doubles, no river,

A short break between the two rounds (max 30 mn),

6 teams in the second round.

**Combinations that participate in this competition may not have participated in competition n°3 (Large Tour) and n°7 (Large tour team competition).**

**Class 11**, 125 cm, "Europa Cup" in **two different rounds**,

Art. 273.4.3 + Rules AMBASSADOR TOUR Series FEI.

Max 2 horses per rider, horse competing for the annual ranking must start first.

#### Obstacles and courses

Height 1.25 m maximum with a spread in proportion not exceeding 1.35 m (1.70 m for the triple bar). At least two vertical obstacles, which must be 1.30 m in height (sloping walls do not count as compulsory vertical obstacles). No water jump.

1<sup>st</sup> round : Table A, against the clock, no water jump, including a double and a triple,

A short break between the two rounds (max 30'), with a new course walk,

2<sup>nd</sup> round : shortened max. 10 obstacles with a double,

Only the best 12 riders after the first round, based on their penalties and time in the first round, or all the clear rounds, are qualified for the second round.

#### **4- Organization of rankings, prizes:**

**Please respect the order of the events**

**Events 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 9:**

- 12 placed, plaques, rosettes, prize in cash at the expense of the organizer
- the first 6 placed must attend the prize giving ceremony on horseback

**Events 7 and 10 (AJA team events):**

- 6 teams placed,
- 4 blankets for the winning team at the expense of the sponsor of AJA,
- 4 scarves to the winning team at the expense of AJA,
- "Prestige" plaques for the 3 classified teams at the expense of AJA,
- Rosettes and cash at the expense of the organizer for the 3 teams,
- 3 first teams placed must attend the prize giving ceremony on horseback.

#### ***Events 6 and 11 (Grand Prix Challenge Cup and Europa Cup):***

- Allocation of points for the AJA finals (Challenge Cup and Europa Cup) to the 12 riders of the second round, (see Ambassador Tour rules)
- Allocation of points for the AJA annual ranking (Challenge Cup and Europa Cup) to the 12 riders of the second round, only for the riders who have paid their annual support to the AJA
- Blanket for the winner at the expense of the sponsor of AJA
- A scarf to the winner at the expense of AJA
- Plates for the first 6 classified at the expense of the AJA
- Rosettes and cash at the expense of the organizer for the 12 placed
- 6 first placed must attend the prize giving ceremony on horseback,

#### **5- Remark:**

- **A good First Aid is very important, with an ambulance stand-by. Please take care that they are well visible and stand-by from 1 hour before the start of the competitions until 1 hour after the last competition of the day.**
- A welcome gift (souvenir stable plaques) at the expense of the organiser
- The welcome drink organization on **Day 0** evening is the responsibility of the organizer
- The AJA evening on **Day 2** evening is set up by the organizer. It is recommended to set the price of the dinner at +/- € 70 (welcome aperitif included), wines at an additional cost
